SCHOOL OFFICE HOURS

The school office will be open from 8:00 am – 3:30 pm Monday through Friday for school business. Please come to the front office and buzz in as usual. We appreciate people wearing face coverings and following social distancing protocol when they come to the office. A limited number of people are able to enter the office at one time, and you can see the markings on the floor which designate where to stand upon entering. If business can be conducted through email or over the phone, please choose that option. We have 3 tables set up in the front airlock area. One table is for turning in beginning-of-the-year registration paperwork. The second is for dropping off any materials or lunches. The third table is designated for picking up any items that have been left for you. Your teachers will indicate if there is something you need to drop off or pick up.

USED UNIFORMS

If you would like to come look through our store for used uniforms, please call the school and make an appointment to do so.

ORIENTATION PAPERWORK

Make sure you have turned in all orientation packet paperwork by Monday, 8/24 at the latest. 7th grade students also need to submit their updated immunization records as well.

HEALTH INFORMATION

If you have notified us on your updated health card that your child needs an Epipen or an asthma inhaler, please make sure that you have sent that into the office so it can be stored in the health room.

LUNCH DROP OFF

Please be reminded that all students need to come to school with their lunches OR parents need to purchase their child's lunch online through www.MyHotLunchbox.com. If a student or parent forgets a lunchbox every now and then, it is fine to drop it off in the airlock area, but we definitely want to avoid parents dropping off restaurant lunches every day. Also, please be reminded again that we will not accept lunches delivered by restaurant delivery drivers. It causes random traffic in the school office during lunchtime. Only parents/guardians will be allowed to deliver a missed lunch, and you can drop it off in the front airlock area on the drop off table. Make sure it is labeled with your child's name so it gets to the right child.

SUPPORTING THE SCHOOL

We always appreciate the support we receive from our parents and parish. There are ways to support us without doing anything other than the things you always do. Our school is registered with **PUBLIX** supermarket and with **HARRIS TEETER** for their school give-back programs. If you shop at these stores, a portion of the sale is donated to our school. You just have to go to the supermarket customer service desk and tell them you'd like to link your purchases to the school. If you have been doing it in the past, you may have to renew every year.

Also, if you are an Amazon shopper, you can open an **AMAZON SMILE** account and designate that you want St. Patrick Catholic Church to receive cash donations from Amazon based on your purchases. (although you link the account to the church, the donations go to the school) There is no difference in an Amazon Smile account from your regular Amazon account. You only log in with Smile.Amazon.com instead of Amazon.com. All your history and Prime benefits are still there. Just by logging in under Smile.Amazon.com, it triggers their donation system. Feel free to share this information with family and friends. We can receive from anyone linked to our school.

 you paint. You are responsible for any damage that you cause to surrounding property when
 painting.
- The rock may not be painted during school hours.
- You may begin painting the rock at 4:00 pm the day before your reserved date. Your reservation will expire at 4:00 pm on your reservation date.
